michael barr explores the complex and covert networks of power at work in one of the world s most prosperous countries the city state of singapore he argues that the contemporary networks of power are a deliberate project initiated and managed by lee kuan yew former prime minister and singapore s founding father designed to empower himself and his family barr identifies the crucial institutions of power including the country s sovereign wealth funds and the government linked companies together with five critical features that form the key to understanding the nature of the networks he provides an assessment of possible shifts of power within the elite in the wake of lee kuan yew s son lee hsien loong assuming power and considers the possibility of a more fundamental democratic shift in singapore s political system

this book examines the staying power of the people s action party a political party that has governed singapore since june 1959 a political titan with few chinks in its armour the party has kept winning elections under three prime ministers and singapore is about to witness a transition to the fourth

prime minister the party's seemingly unstoppable sterling performance makes the issue of the durability of the PAP highly critical in light of the serious weakness of the opposition and the strong performance legitimacy of the ruling party it is worthwhile asking the question can the PAP stumble and fall addressing this question is highly relevant given that similar political parties and structures have almost all collapsed elsewhere the Barisan Nasional as the latest casualty with its defeat in Malaysia's 2018 general elections with an extensive coverage on domestic and international issues up to date developments on the finalisation of the PAP's 4th leadership the Workers Party town council saga and the efforts to form an opposition coalition led by Tan Cheng Bock are also analysed in this book
